The Arctic Circle runs right through the middle of Grímsey and all those who step over the Circle can receive a special, illuminated certificate to confirm it. Grímsey is

The 100 metre high cliffs on the island's east coast are the nesting place of many species of birds and one of the best sites in the country for birdwatching.
